

Below Itinerary is for reference only and is subject to any necessary changes in accordance to local requirements.

5 Days Lemanak Long House

Departure : Departure Daily
Minimum : 02 pax on SIC basis


Day 1 Brunei - Miri - Kuching

Standby at the airport 2 hours before flight depart. Upon arrival at Kuching, transfer to hotel and check in.

Day 2 Kuching - Semenggok Orang Utan - Long House

Early morning depart to visit the Semenggok Orang Utan Rehabilitation Centre that houses the Orang Utan and sometimes other protected species of wildlife rescued from captivity. These wildlife are then carefully nurtured and rehabilitated into their natural surroundings. Witness the feeding of the Orang Utans and this is subject to the animals approaching the feeding platform. However always bear in mind that the main aim of the Centre is to return these animals back into their habitat. Do not be disappointed if you do not see any roaming the jungles or coming back to feed as this means they are able to forage on their own and do not need human assistance.

Enroute to our next stop, we stop at Serian town to visit the native market & pepper garden. On request, we can also make roadside stop to see bamboo orchids and pitcher plants. Lunch will be at Lachau village.



On arrival, we will take a boat to visit and tour a Longhouse. In the evening, enjoy a native dinner prepared by the Ibans. Menu includes such as bamboo shoots, jungle ferns, cucumber leaves, palm hearts and so on together with rice. After dinner, witness traditional dances and join in to the tribal revelry in the Longhouse. Here is a chance to try the local rice wine, tuak. Overnight in a simple guesthouse located beside an Iban longhouse (basic accommodation consisting of individual beds with mosquito netting. There are common shower and toilet facility) (Meal: Lunch, Dinner)



Day 3 Lemanak

Breakfast at the guesthouse. Enjoy the demonstration of the native activities such as cockfighting and method of using blowpipe for hunting, followed by a short nature walk to learn about some local medicinal plants. We will pass by ancient burial grounds and learn about how animal traps are set. Descend to a river bank, here we will take a longboat upriver, negotiating more rapids and bends of the Lemanak River. As we continue up river and detour to a tributary of the Lemanak River, we will be making a few stops to collect jungle produces. Continue downriver back to the guesthouse for dinner and overnight (Meal: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 4 Lemanak – Kuching

After breakfast, we will travel by longboat down river where we will catch the coach back to Kuching. Lunch en route at Ranchan Waterfall. Visit a pottery factory along the way. Arrive Kuching in the late afternoon. Overnight. (Meal: Breakfast & Lunch)

** Sighting of wildlife is not guaranteed.

Day 5 Kuching - Miri - Brunei

Free & easy the whole day until time to transfer to the airport for your onward flight back Miri. Upon arrival at Miri, transfer back to Brunei.

Friendly Note:

Cockfighting is a tradition and friendly sport of the natives, it does not involve any dangerous tools that can endanger the lives of the birds. In fact, cocks are well loved pets, held in high regards and generally cherished by their native owners.

What to bring:

Due to the basic conditions at the Longhouse, you are advice to bring your own raincoat, hand-torch, personal toiletries, light clothing preferably cotton materials, towel, body soap, walking shoe with rubber base/slippers, anti malaria tablets, insect repellent, sun protection lotion & first aid kit.

Due to the nature of the program, it is not advisable to bring along your suitcase which is advisable to leave them in Kuching. Should you like to bring gifts for the people at the Longhouse, biscuits, medical first aid kit, books, pencils, pens, educational toys and dolls are highly appreciated. We discourage giving sweets and cigarettes.
