DAY 01	HKG → BWN Bandar Seri Begawan is the capital of Brunei Darussalam. Brunei economy is heavily dependent on oil and gas industry. The historical landmarks in Brunei attract foreign tourists.

DAY 02	<u>BRUNEI OILFIELD</u> After breakfast, you will be brought to visit Seria -the oil town of Brunei En route Tutong scenic Town passing through crystal white sand while making a stop at Sungai Liang Forestry Museum . Oil was first drawn from Brunei soil at Seria in 1929; active ' nodding donkey ' oil wells are still a common sight in the vicinity, although Seria itself remains an oasis of relative peace after the bustle of Bandar. The Oil & Gas Discovery Centre - an interactive science centre set up by Brunei Shell Petroleum to create awareness of the petroleum industry and stimulate interest in science and technology. Next, visit to the Billionth Barrel Monument , built to commemorate the production of the billionth barrel of oil by Seria oilfield & visit Oil & Gas Discovery Center . The cool sea breeze makes this a delightful area in which to relax. The monument is just a 5-minute drive from town centre.

Day 03	<u>BRUNEI CITY TOUR</u> After breakfast, we set off to the dazzling Jerudong Park and Garden - 20 minutes from downtown Bandar Seri Begawan. At the park, be marveled by the beauty of the largest man-made Crystal set at the centre of the amusement park. Next, Royal Regalia - built to commemorate the 1992 Silver Jubilee of His Majesty's ascension to the throne. It holds a collection of ceremonial regalia such as the royal chariot, gold and silver armory, and full documentation of the history of the Constitution of Brunei Darussalam. After lunch, visit to the world's largest residential palace - Istana Nurul Iman then Jame Asr Mosque , the most magnificent mosque in Brunei today, with 29 shimmering golden domes. After that enjoy yourself shopping at the Yayasan Shopping Complex , currently the largest shopping complex in Brunei, don't forget to bring your camera with u! You can get a great view of Omar Ali Saifuddien Mosque at the center of the shopping complex, surrounded by a man-made lagoon where the 16 th century royal barge reposes. It features resplendent marble and granite floors, stained glass and chandeliers from all over the world.		
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Day 04	<u>PRBOSCIS MONKEY & WATER VILLAGE</u> Spend a leisure morning with a late breakfast and free time at the hotel. After lunch, prepare a journey to KAMPUNG AYER (water village) the sprawling jumble of timber houses that stretches eight kilometers along the Brunei River. The tilted city is a collection of small kampongs/villages, each interconnected by a maze of wooden walkways. The community is almost self-contained with stores, mosques, schools, a police station, clinics and a centuries-old tradition of living over water. Take a boat ride on "water taxis" to visit a local residence in the water village , and enjoy some tea & local cakes. <i>The one species that you can only find in Borneo Island!!</i> Journey starts with river safari along Brunei River passing through green dense forest across the Brunei Bay & Mangrove swamp. At low tide when the sandbanks are exposed you'll see numerous multi color fiddler crab as well as mudskippers of different sizes. White- bellied Sea Eagles & King Fishers are commonly seen. Proceed to the other island in search of Proboscis Monkeys with distinctive features of pendulous pink noses & potbellies.
